ROADWAY: 2300 Block Tague Ave

SPEED SURVEY

November 2024

INITIAL COMPLAINT: The Traffic Safety Unit conducted this survey based on a complaint from a resident.

DESCRIPTION OF AREA: The 2300 block of Tague Ave is a two-lane roadway posted at 25 MPH. It intersects Easton Rd. to the east and Kelly Ln to the west. It is located in the Glenside section of Abington Township. There are some residential homes on the north and south sides of the street.

INFORMATION GATHERING METHOD: Speed survey was conducted with a RADAR TRAFFIC COUNTER. The counter is attached to a pole and uses radar to record traffic volume and speed data. Crash data was obtained from the closest two intersections (Easton Rd to the east and Kelly Ln. to the west) for the past 5 years. There were no crashes at Tague Ave and Kelly Ln. There were 2 crashes at Easton Rd and Tague Ave. A vehicle hit an illegally parked car and there was a stop sign violation causing an angle crash. There were 2 mid-block crashes, both were side swipes of parked vehicles.

FACTORS: The speed of the vehicles using Tague Ave. showed that 0% of the traffic met the criteria for enforcement. The 85th percentile speed for Tague Ave was 26 MPH. 929 vehicles were monitored in this survey.

ANALYSIS: At this time, speeding does not seem to be an issue Tague Ave. The average speed was 23 MPH. Based on the analysis, the roadway appears to be appropriately posted.

RECOMMENDATIONS: A speed sign will be put on the block (when available) to make motorists more aware of their speed.
